

Where Do I Find Roblox Promo Codes?

If you're a parent like me, I am willing to bet your kids are also one of the 16 million American children currently hooked on Roblox. Roblox is a game that allows players to create online worlds, both simple and complex, which they can share with others and play together.

The developers are dedicated to keeping kids safe online, with strict codes of conduct and moderation. Building these worlds requires computer coding, which is a high-value skill in today's world. While video games are typically seen as little more than mindless, this is a game you want your children to play.

If your kids are anything like mine, they aren't cool if they don't have the latest and greatest in-game "stuff" — you know, the things that "all their friends have." In Roblox, you can make and sell products in-game that make your avatar stand out through a little ingenuity and coding knowledge. While it's a pain getting my child to dress for the weather, they can accessorize their Roblox avatar with ease. While these are cosmetic customizations, no doubt your child wants to keep up with all the latest hype.

Why Should I Hunt for Roblox Promo Codes?

One of the best features of Roblox is the ability to create custom character avatars. From shirts and hats to little birds riding around on your shoulder, your child can be as unique as their imagination allows. Unfortunately, these items aren't free by default and must be purchased with in-game currency called Robux.

Robux may be purchased with real money, although they can be earned in-game as well. Currently, 400 Robux will cost you around five American dollars. It may seem like a lot, but Roblox items range anywhere from 100 to a few thousand Robux. Currently, the maximum amount of Robux you can purchase is 22,500 for 200 American Dollars.

You read that right, \$200 of hard-earned currency. You can try to convince yourself that it's worth it because who doesn't want their kid to be happy, right? Well, thankfully, there is another much cheaper option available — Roblox promo codes!

You can use one of the many promotional codes available online. These codes appear monthly and with special events in-game, like the Easter egg hunt in April. They will help you save money, and your child's avatar can still get that super sweet white cat wizard hat.

Some examples of other content you can acquire through promo codes include;

- Shield of the Sentinel - available through an official Roblox educational game.
- Fiery Fox Shoulder Pal - a little red fox to ride around on your avatar's shoulders.

- Gnarly Triangle Headphones - a giant pair of blue and purple headphones. They're not too practical, but man, they look cool!

That's only a few of the items currently available, so continue reading to find out the best place to find them all!

Keep in mind that some of these Roblox promo codes are monthly, so if you take too long snatching them up, you're unfortunately out of luck. You might also be wondering what the catch is — the good news is, there is no catch! These promo codes are all valid and recognized by the Roblox developers themselves.

You cannot get promo codes for valuable Robux, so you'll have to find other means for that. Robux should be purchased in Roblox directly, and online generators and supposed Robux promos should be strictly avoided. At the very least, your child's account gets compromised, and at worst, their identity gets stolen.

How Do I Use Roblox Promo Codes?

For parents, the most critical part is how do you redeem these promos when you get them? It's super simple, and you or your child can do it in three easy steps!

1. Access the official Roblox code redemption webpage [here](http://www.roblox.com/promocodes) (www.roblox.com/promocodes) from your computer or mobile device.
1. Log in to your Roblox account, enter your Roblox promo code, and click 'Redeem.'
1. Voila! Your child has new things! For real, that's all there is to it!

Alright, Show me the Roblox Promo Codes Already!

The sites I'll be referencing are legitimate and provide working Roblox promo codes, that is, until they expire after their monthly runs. Make sure to stay far away from sites that promise free items or offer items in exchange for personal information.

As promised, here are some of the best resources for Roblox promo codes online. There are several of them, and be mindful that most have the same codes posted. Note that if the code your child wants expires, it could very well pop up again at another time.

- [robloxcodes](#): Not only can you find the latest Roblox promo codes here, it will tell you when they are expiring, and you'll even be able to see when limited edition codes are all taken. Aside from promo codes, this site has even more to offer its users. Game codes are available for your child to build worlds in-game. There are creator challenges that will

provide even more free stuff when completed! They are even fairly educational, which should make you feel better about letting your kid play them.

- [gfinityesports](#): A website dedicated to video games; they'll scrape the internet for promo codes. This website is not as front and center with them as the previous contender. They want you to read a bit on these codes before finding them at the bottom of the page. It's nothing you haven't already learned by reading this article, so scroll to the bottom for your codes! As codes expire, make sure to keep an eye out for new ones. This site is excellent at tracking down promo codes when they drop.
- [pockettactics.com](#): This is a solid option and even offers more codes than anywhere else — although it's unclear if they're all currently valid or not. They even break down and give advice on in-game challenges to help your robloxian win those harder-to-get "exclusive" items.
- [levvvel.com](#): While they provide the same codes as the others, there is another perk with levvvel.com. If you have a Twitch or Amazon Prime account, you may be able to access even more free promo codes! Twitch users can get free games in Roblox as well. With levvvel, the free stuff keeps coming, and who wouldn't want that?

A Note About Roblox Promo Code Generators

If you choose to look for sites on your own, be aware of those who take advantage of this popular game and its younger audience. 'Free code generators' or 'Free Robux generators' are a dime a dozen, I even found 30 different ones researching this article alone. The official statement from Roblox, as stated on their [support page](#) is:

"There is no such thing as a Robux Generator. If a person, website, or game tries to tell you there is one, this is a scam and should be reported via our Report Abuse System."

While Roblox speaks of Robux specifically here, fake Roblox promo items exist as well. Here's how it works:

1. You visit a free Robux or Roblox code generator site.
1. You need to provide your username and password to get your 'custom' code.
1. You'll see a pretty cool little animation that looks like you're about to make it big!
1. When complete, your child will rush over to their Roblox account to see their new goodies or their big pile of Robux.
1. Not only will there be no new goodies, all the goodies your child had previously will be gone, stolen by the folks they handed their over account access to.

Most don't think it'll happen to them. Maybe you think you found the ONE legitimate site — well, so did my son not too long ago. Through a YouTube video, he found a link and graciously provided his login info, losing everything he had in a matter of minutes. To make matters worse, I didn't know about Roblox promo codes at the time. Everything he possessed, from his avatar outfit to the big pile of Robux he was comfortably sitting on, I had purchased with my own money, and now it was all gone.

If you go that route and your child doesn't lose everything, consider yourself one of the few lucky ones. But note that Roblox will still ban your child if they find out about any generator usage, and it's safer to always assume they will. Don't try and cut corners when there are so many legitimate free options for your child already. You can also let them do chores to earn Robux for themselves. Perhaps, you'll feel better about spending real money than I did.

Robux For Everyone!

As a former gamer myself, I understand the allure of games to my children. I'm thankful though that the games available to my children have more to offer than the ones of my day. I spent countless hours in World of Warcraft mindlessly raiding, while today, my kids can learn to code and have fun while gaming.
