## Chicago City Children's Hospital Celebrates \$150M 'Winfrey Wing' Focusing on Cystic Fibrosis Treatment and Research

New 130,000 square foot, state-of-the-art children's wing will be home to the first program providing inpatient and outpatient care to cystic fibrosis patients through their adulthood.

CHICAGO (July 21, 2017) – Chicago City Children's Hospital (CCCH) celebrates the opening of the Oprah Winfrey Wing, a \$150 million dollar, state-of-the-art inpatient and outpatient building focused on cystic fibrosis (CF) treatment and research. Its integration of the newest technology make the Winfrey Wing at the forefront of caring for complex pediatric patients. CF is a life-threatening genetic disease that primarily affects the lungs and digestive system. An estimated 30,000 children currently in the U.S. live with CF.

Oprah Winfrey donated \$20 million dollars for the naming of the wing. The Winfrey Wing is CCCH's first major milestone since embarking on its expansion and fundraising effort to double the amount of beds, care programs and research grant funding.

Chicago Mayor Rahm Emmanuel said, "This new program will further enhance Chicago's standing as one of the world leaders in healthcare and help some of our most vulnerable citizens and their families get stronger together in the most advanced setting possible."

On Friday evening, July 21, 2017, a ceremonial ribbon cutting will take place followed by tours of the facility and a reception.
