


AUFORIOUE

We chose to get married in the Bay of Plenty because there's no place like home. My favourite thing about this region is how relaxed it is, plus it lends itself well to weddings because the weather is relatively reliable.

We exchanged vows in Ataahua's walled garden and held our reception in the adjacent dining room. Ataahua is stunning, so we didn't need to do much, but I found some vintage suitcases and made bunting, then trusted Shaye from On My Hand for special extras and flowers; my face lit up when I saw the arrangement she'd created for over the fireplace.

Our day had so many highlights, but some that really stand out were arriving in a Kombi van from Lovedubs, our catering by Hereford Kitchen (our guests raved about it for months afterwards) and our chocolate raspberry, banoffee dulce and lemon sherbet cake by Spongedrop – it was to die for!

FOR EVENTS WITH A...

BEACH VIBE: Waihi Beach's On the Beach (onthebeachweddings.co.nz) has a floor-to-ceiling view of the waves. Hold your ceremony on the sand, then amble across the lawn to the dining room where a fully catered feast awaits.

VINTAGE SLANT: try Old Forest School in Pongakawa (oldforestschool.co.nz), a restored 1930s school house set on three acres studded with spots for photos, Hold a rustic reception at Redwood Stables and stay in the historic forestry cabins on site. COUNTRY LODGE APPEAL: opt for Treetops Lodge in Rotorua (treetops.co.nz). Newly renovated, it's surrounded by an 800-yearold forest, offers various settings and can cater to events of any size. Complete with villas, lodge rooms, a spa, a gym and access to a golf course, you'll want for nothing. FRENCH FLAVOUR: check out The French Country House in Pahoia (thefrench countryhouse.co.nz). A blend of classic and contemporary on a property with all the romance of the Gallic countryside, you'll be smitten with its opulent décor, glorious gardens and luxury on-site accommodation.

Craft Collective (craftcollective.co.nz) creates customised celebrations. Enjoy an art lesson, make soap, screen-print a cushion or even make your own clutch. Or consider a workshop at Pickled Whimsy (pickledwhimsy.co.nz), where you'll learn how to build terrariums and kokedama (Japanese moss balls) that could be used to beautify your reception.

AND FOR HIM... Let the boys be boys on a stag do at Te Puke's Equine Estate Sporting Claybirds (equinesportingclaybirds. co.nz). Surrounded by native bush, they can take aim to their hearts' content, accompanied by an experienced guide.





BEFORE & AFTER

AS WELL AS SURFING AND SUNBATHING (SPF IN TOW!), THE BOP HAS MYRIAD ACTIVITIES TO KEEP YOU ENTERTAINED

- Enjoy a picnic at Bowentown, a family-friendly cove near Waihi Beach, then shake off the post-feast sleepiness with a wander over the hill to explore the opposite side of the peninsula.
- A short drive from Whakatane is Ohope, where just 15 minutes walk from the main beach you'll find magical Otarawairere Bay, accessible only by foot or kayak.
- No visit to the Bay of Plenty is complete for international guests without a trip to Rotorua. Or take a break with your bridesmaids at Polynesian Spa (polynesianspa.co.nz), where you can indulge in thermal-mud spa treatments.
- Take a tour to explore two of the region's offshore gems: active volcano White Island, and wildlife and plant sanctuary Whale Island. Visit whiteisland.co.nz.
- Spend a romantic evening paddling amid the swans on a lake lit by glow worms. At McLaren Falls Park in the Kaimai Ranges, you'll be guided through the tranquil waterways at dusk. Visit waimarino.com.
- Appease your adventurous side with the rush of a whitewater rafting expedition.

"Face away from the sun during your ceremony to get beautiful backlit photos and avoid squinty eyes. Try using the Sun Seeker app to see where the sun will be positioned."

"Suspend a canopy of lace over the bridal party during the ceremony to shade their faces."

"Ask your guests to take their sunglasses off when they're being snapped so you can see the emotion in their eyes."

4. Make the most of the rays.

"Provide parasols or hats to add n extra dimension to your images."

"The Bay abounds with photogenic forests and bush. Try Rotoehu Forest in Pongakawa or the Redwoods in Rotorua."

"Bring a festival theme to your wedding photos at Mount Maunganui's Little Big Markets and Gourmet Night Market."

7. "Lakes, rivers and beaches are easily accessible in this district. Check out Pukehina Beach, Lake Rotoma and Lake Rotoiti."
