



whatever happened to: JEREMY LONDON?

Not to be confused with his identical twin, Jason, also an actor, Jeremy London became a fan favourite in the late '90s as *Party of Five's* Griffin and on squeaky-clean *7th Heaven*. Off camera, though, London was anything but clean. In fact, he was high, which led to his arrest in 2004 for driving with a suspended licence and carrying controlled substances. Five years later, he staggered into rehab.

By last June London had been sober for seven months. Then things went awry again. He says he and wife Melissa Cunningham were fixing a flat tyre when they were kidnapped and forced to take drugs during a terrifying 12-hour joyride. His now estranged family says that's a load of

bull and he'd just fallen off the wagon; and the alleged abductor, Brandon Adams, says London had asked him for pills and was totally into it.

That both London, 38, and Cunningham submit to drug tests due to issues related to the custody of their three-year-old son casts further doubt on their kidnap claims – as does the fact that Cunningham's 'ordeal' was cut short when she asked Adams to drop her off at home, please. Nevertheless, at an initial hearing the judge decided there was enough evidence to send Adams to trial.
