The Tuft & Needle mattress is a foam mattress that is made up of two distinct foam layers. This company utilizes a straightforward approach to the construction of their mattress and do not add any frills because they don't need to. Their mattress stands on its own. The first layer is called the comfort layer. It's made of 3" proprietary Tuft & Needle Adaptive® Foam, which consists of a mixture of material that mimics the feel of latex and memory foam. This layer offers pressure relief to sleepers and does not trap heat like a traditional memory foam mattress. This layer responds quickly to pressure and has a decent amount of bounce, which makes it easy for restless sleepers to move around during the night without feeling like they're stuck in a sinkhole. Beneath that is the base, which is a layer of 7" polyfoam. This layer is the foundation of the mattress. It's much firmer than the comfort layer and offers the most support to sleepers.

Quality Mattress on a Budget

If you're looking for a deal and want a mattress that's high quality for the best, most affordable price, you want the Tuft & Needle mattress. While it's not exactly a luxury mattress, it falls just beneath that line, and still has many of the same features customers crave in a foam bed, just without the fancy frills. The Tuft & Needle mattress sits in a lower price range without compromising quality. This is accomplished by determining the three most important qualities that are necessary for a top-notch mattress and perfecting those things. To do this, Tuft & Needle focused directly on creating a mattress that offers support, pressure relief, and cooling technology to prevent overheating.

Through trials and testing, they've worked to refine their design to make a mattress that is universally comfortable to the average sleeper. This company actually cares about the feedback they receive from customers and have made quite a few changes and upgrades in the past to reflect customers' preferences, like making the bed softer.

How Does the Tuft & Needle Feel?

In test studies, participants determined the average firmness of the Tuft & Needle mattress to be 7.5 out of 10. This level of firmness comfortably accommodates the average back and stomach sleeper. With this rating, the Tuft & Needle is one of the firmer foam mattresses out there. However, it is still a foam mattress and is not considered very firm. People who have slept on this mattress report good pressure relief for their back, neck, and hips, and enjoy the easy freedom of movement provided by the bounce in the comfort layer. Like other foam mattresses, the Tuft & Needle performs well in motion transfer tests, showing minimal disturbance. This makes it a perfect mattress for couples because it allows both sleepers the freedom to move during the night, without worrying about waking their partner and getting an earful from them in the morning.

Edge support is the one area that did not perform as well as similar foam mattresses in a higher price range. Users reported that the edges sank low and did not consistently hold a firm shape over time. However, Tuft & Needle listens to customer feedback and is committed to making improvements based on these reviews. Overall, this mattress is the best foam mattress option in this price range.

The Right Mattress for You If:

This mattress is ideal for shoppers looking for a quality mattress on a budget, who don't mind a mattress without all the bells and whistles. Instead, Tuft & Needle focuses on mattress quality. If you're looking for the frills, there are some great options in a slightly higher price range. The Tuft & Needle is a straightforward mattress that is designed to comfortably accommodate all sleeping styles. However, the type of sleepers who were most satisfied after sleeping on this mattress was back and stomach sleepers. Back sleepers, in particular, tend to find this design especially relaxing and supportive because it is on the firmer side for a foam bed. This is a great option if you are looking for something firmer, but still crave the feeling of sinking into a foam mattress. Likewise, stomach sleepers report a comfortable night's sleep on this mattress. Many thought the mattress was soft enough to allow for easy breathing, but firm enough to prevent the hips from sinking too low and putting strain on the lower back. For both of these sleep styles, the firm base layer provides much-needed support that helps maintain a neutral spine alignment throughout the night. If you're looking for a mattress with quick responsiveness, this is a great choice. The top layer has enough bounce that allows for easy position changes without causing the bed to shake like an earthquake.

Others who loved this mattress mentioned the stress-free buying process, saying that it was simple and convenient to order and return. What really sold them on it was the low risk of purchase. The bed comes with a 100 night risk-free trial period where your satisfaction is guaranteed. If you end up deciding it's not the bed for you, no problem. Just send it back.

Not Your Ideal Mattress If:

Based on our research and customer testimonials, side sleepers, especially those who are heavier, were not as responsive to this mattress. Some felt that the mattress did not provide

enough pressure relief for their shoulders and hips, especially when sleeping curled up. Other side sleepers mentioned that they felt that this mattress was too firm for their liking.

On the other hand, if you're looking for a traditional, classic-feeling memory foam mattress, this isn't the bed for you. Since it isn't made with memory foam, but with a similar material, it does not have the slow-sinking feeling of traditional memory foam. It does not have a soft pillow top, so it feels firmer instead of plush.

What are People Saying About Tuft & Needle?

Our friends over at Sleep Advisor gave the Tuft & Needle a solid 9/10, which is an impressive score. The mattress was rated by a strict set of standards, taking into consideration the quality of materials, support and comfort, cooling, edge support, value for money.

Overall, the majority of customers were highly satisfied with their new Tuft & Needle mattress. This is especially true of back and stomach sleepers, with many claiming to see back pain improvements after buying this mattress. One review satisfied sleeper shared, "I have chronic lower back issues and was afraid it might be too soft. That is not the case."

Through our research, we heard many customers praise the customer service experience they had dealing with this company. Most interactions were quick, convenient and courteous. A common trend we couldn't help but notice was that many loyal customers felt good supporting such a transparent and reputable company who actually listens to their customers. At this time, some people reporting that the mattress was beginning to lose its firm shape. Some customers shared that their mattress developed grooves and sink spots, while others said that it seemed like the material became softer over time. While the initial sinkage of this mattress was only a few inches, it seems like the sinkage of the material does increase with time and wear.

However, since everyone is different and nothing will ever be one-size-fits-all, we believe your best bet is to try this mattress out for yourself if this sounds like a mattress that suits your needs.
