

The event opens with *Uncle Frank*, written and directed by Alan Ball (*American Beauty*). The film stars Paul Bettany, Sophia Lillis and Peter Macdissi. Watch the director and the cast discuss the film in more detail in this interview on *Collider*.

On the 8 August, we'll be screening *Luxor*, directed by Zeina Durra (*The Imperialists Are Still Alive!*). *Deadline*'s interview with stars Andrea Riseborough and Karim Saleh sees both actors talk about the film that changed their lives.
