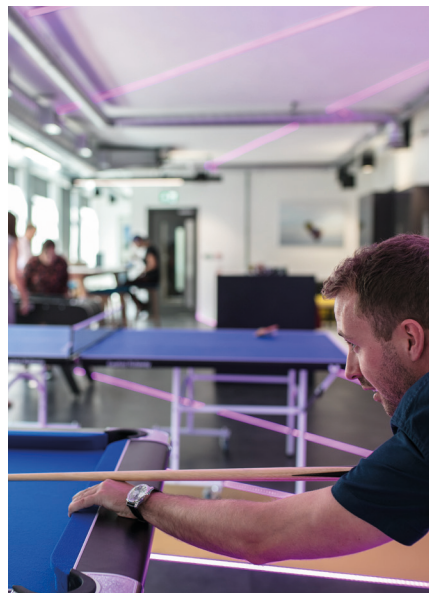


NEX's new workplace: good things come in threes
