# Minnesota woman captures motorcycle wreck on dashcam

## Dashcam Shows Motorcyclist Crashing Into Unsecured Load On I-94 Minnesota

A Minnesota woman's dashcam caught the moment a motorcycle crashed.

On June 18, Linda Leverty was headed east in the middle lane on I-94 near Woodbury, Minn., when she saw a rolled-up, yellow pad release from the back of a boat hinged to an SUV in the left lane. Brenden Jankowski, 20, – of Hudson, Wisc. – was riding his motorcycle, behind the truck.

He unsuccessfully tried to swerve out of path the tumbling pad. The collision sent him and his bike flipping through the air; both crashed to the ground, spinning from the momentum.

"Never in my wildest dreams did I think I'd catch anything like this," Levery, 55, told the Daily News on Wednesday. She bought the camera four months ago to record wildlife she encountered while driving.

Levery said that Jankowski was able to walk to the left shoulder of the highway on his own, out of the way of further danger.



The collision sent Jankowski and his motorcycle tumbling through the air.

The SUV did not stop.

The video had over 11,000 views on YouTube, as of Wednesday afternoon.

State Patrol, and Woodbury fire and police departments responded to the scene, according to the Minneapolis Star Tribune. Jankowski was taken to Regions Hospital in St. Paul, where he was treated for minor injuries, the paper reported.

“I don’t want to see something like that again,” Leverty told the Tribune on Tuesday.

Investigators could not be reached for comment, but are still looking for the driver of the SUV, according to the paper.
