

Burned body found in Rochester, second this week

A burned body was found in La Grane Park in Rochester, NY Wednesday morning. It's the second burned body found in the area this week.

A burned body was found in a park in Rochester, N.Y., Wednesday morning.

Police received a call around 6:21 a.m. from a passerby claiming to have seen a body on the ground, "which appeared to have been set on fire," according to Police Investigator Frank Camp.

"The Rochester Fire Department and Rochester Police Department did respond, and determined that the person was deceased," Camp told the [Democrat & Chronicle](#) on Wednesday. Authorities have not yet identified the person's gender, or identity.

This is [the second burned](#) body found in the Rochester area this week.

New York State Police Captain Richard Allen said that authorities received a call Monday night from a person who had spotted a burning body beside a road in Livingston County. After arriving at the scene, authorities found the body charred beyond recognition. Police are probing the case as a homicide.

"We're working together right now, but there doesn't seem to be (any evidence) linking the two," Allen told the Daily News on Wednesday.

Neither the Rochester Police Department nor the Rochester Fire Department returned the Daily News' request for comment.
