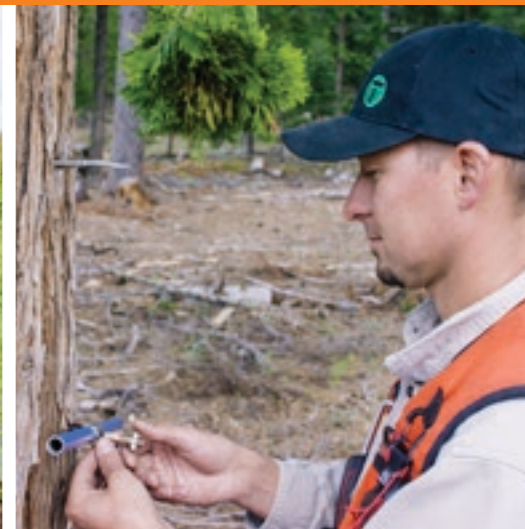




Responsible Forestry



Michigan-California Timber Company (MCTC), an affiliate of Timber Products Company, responsibly manages approximately 114,000 acres of forestland in



Northern California. We are dedicated to preserving more than just trees, but the entire ecosystem: water, wildlife, fisheries, air quality, scenic vistas and recreational areas.

Trees harvested from our forestlands are sent to our nearby softwood veneer mill, allowing us to control both the cost and the quality of our products.

Robust Tree Planting

We plant approximately 350,000 trees each year, a key component to the long-term sustainability of our forests. This includes Douglas fir, white fir, ponderosa pine and sugar pine grown from seed collected from our lands. These seeds have been sorted by elevation and seed zone to ensure that only the best genetics are passed on to future generations.

Forest Management

Timber Products subscribes to and complies with the high standards and objectives of the Sustainable Forestry Initiative® (SFI) and the comprehensive California Forest Practices Act, the toughest set of forest protection laws in the country. MCTC lands have been voluntarily third-party certified by SFI for over 15 years and are audited annually. Timber Products Company's log and timber procurement program is also third-party SFI certified and holds a Forest Stewardship Council® (FSC®) Chain-of-Custody certification.

Thinking Beyond Forestry

We work with geologists, botanists and wildlife biologists to preserve our forests' unique qualities. Our Registered Professional Foresters and professional wildlife and fisheries managers work together to develop management and harvest plans that produce the timber we need while promoting biodiversity and wildlife conservation.

Wildlife Habitat Conservation

We work to enhance the quality of wildlife habitat by promoting biodiversity in plant and animal populations. In the springtime, we go to our forestlands to call out spotted owls and map where they have decided to nest, mindfully noting this for our harvest plans.

Harvest Rotation

We rotate our harvest across the land in order to maintain a mix of different habitat types and trees of different ages. This helps keep our

forests healthy, productive and more resistant to fire, insects and other pathogens.

Salvage Logging

We quickly respond to beetle outbreaks and other related pathogens to harvest damaged timber before the disease or insect infestation can spread to the adjacent stands. We've ramped up that program during the California drought to ensure our forests remain healthy and productive.

We carefully prepare and implement harvest plans, keeping our timberlands healthy and providing a steady supply of timber to Timber Products. We also manage reforestation after harvest, strategically thin the stands and manage 800 miles of road on the land.
