

Healing the Cosmic Uterus

Conflict, the play that some one else wrote...So many conflicts, death at the worst, estrangement at least; hurt, misunderstanding, loss of relationship. What does it take to stay in a relationship? Commitment. Commitment to learn whatever the skills that are necessary to stay in the relationship regardless of the circumstances.

Today, women talk of men's inability to be sensitive, to listen, and to be vulnerable, yet are not women in the work place insensitive, fostering discord, which is entertaining as a soap opera, gossiping, spreading rumors? Do not female supervisors abuse female subordinates worse than any man? Many women would say, in truth, yes.

There is the call for equality with men, yet women among themselves in the work place are scrambling over each other to get ahead. What equality in that? In truth, none. There is something that brings women into this style of relating to other women and it does no good. Women say men run this world, yet they smile at the thought that behind every great man is a woman. Women say that men run the business world, yet behind every corporation are the stock holders, and women live longer than men, so who ends up with all the stock? Who runs the Human Resource Department of corporations? Women. Sure, men hire, but who recruits the prospects? Who qualifies the prospects? Who? Women. Men pick only those that the women in the Human Resources Department approve. Who really runs a business? Most people would agree that the secretaries at all levels run the place. A man that does not please the executive secretary does not last long. Yet, women cry that men rule. Why do men go to war? To protect women. Do women stand with their men in war? Mostly not. How many wars would there be if women were in the front lines? Initially I would suggest none. However with women now pushing to get into the front lines, well great. "Here's my rifle lady. You want it so bad? It's yours. We men will just head for home and you can go blow yourselves to pieces trying to blow other people to pieces. Hope you're happy now!

Illusion rules reality, and to whose benefit? Will a powerful woman be satisfied with a small home, a single car, and a limited wardrobe? No. Beautiful and bright women get the most capable men who earn money to support the appetite of their beautiful and bright wives. Most men care only to please their women, who send them out after more and more. Who runs Washington D.C.? Again, most would acknowledge that behind the scenes women rule. They control the social tides of Washington that raise and crush men. Most would acknowledge this. Then what is really happening?

What is happening is that there is an illness that has spread through women. Ideally, women would be nurturing, supportive, caring, unconditional in their acceptance, they would be sure that all were clothed, fed, housed, and cared for when ill. Is this something to disdain? Sure, men should also have these qualities. These are great qualities, yet women feel "trapped" by them. Disdained, these values are shunt aside and is there not a relationship between the collapse of society and the collapse of the respect for these values? When women disdain these ideals, the core of society rots away.

Women do not disdain these values consciously. They are confused and righteous in their confusion. They choose to go to work for they choose to go along with the erosion of the standard of living that prevents a man from making sufficient money for most families to live on. When Geraldine Ferraro was the vice-presidential candidate, a historic moment was at hand. Did women vote for their gender and place the first woman in such a position thereby opening up a whole frontier? No. Many women refused to vote for another woman just because she was a woman or from the other political party. How short sighted was that? Who should care which party she belonged to? Women had the power to open the door to executive power and chose not to do so. Why? Because the ploy of women is to blame men for the ills of life, and to maintain that illusion, Geraldine Ferraro would not be allowed her historic moment. Certainly there is disease, poverty, hunger, homelessness and abandoned children in troubling numbers in our society. Certainly if the culture was operating properly those issues would be addressed. These symptoms are indicative of a cultural illness and one that has undermined the will of the people to address these needs. When the Clinton administration, with the encouragement of Hillary Clinton, attempted to provide universal health coverage, the effort was defeated by those who had health coverage. The issues of uncovered illness became secondary to the argument of individual freedom to choose one's doctor, even though most of those who had coverage were covered by HMO's where one has only limited choice and by PPO's through which they had free choice of their doctors. Where were the values of care and concern? Where were the women? Why did they not come forward and champion these ideals of love and concern? What excuse did the women have to turn their faces away from the babies born without prenatal and postnatal care? Where are the women when children whose parents can't afford health insurance are growing up without dental care, without glasses, and without the basic medical needs? How well can an uninsured poor mother or father care for their children

when ill, when they, the provider, cannot perform their parental duties because of unattended illness?

Women in general can't be this uncaring on purpose. This can't really be a society of well-off women who are so self-centered that they are willing to consciously choose to ignore the cries of babies and children, the moans of the ill, the suffering of the hungry. There has to be an excuse, a reason for this unnatural behavior. Some agent, something must be subverting women's ability to respond, to care for those in need. Perhaps a virus of some kind has infected women as a group and this virus has the ability to veil reality so that the cries cannot in fact be heard, and if they are heard, the response mechanism is blocked. Something must be inhibiting women from acting as caring beings. They vote, but do not vote as a block to ensure the care of the needy. Deep inside they must acknowledge that they must take responsibility for domestic suffering caused by their lack of care, their lack of willingness to act, or at least to vote for representatives that would promote and ensure the care of all of our people.

So, there must be a disease infecting the core of society; the core that has always been a culture's women. It is a women's illness and this illness will be terminal if not addressed. Who are to address it? Women. Women must take responsibility. Women must learn the nature of this disease and focus to the necessary depths to slow its spread and the affect of this disease sufficiently until a vaccine of some form can be developed. Perhaps the very coming together of women with this in focus would begin to inhibit the power of this virus.

In our culture, through cesarean births, the uterus is cut, the baby lifted forth, and then healing of the uterus must take place. During this healing time the torn wall of the uterus must fuse to promote healing.

In our limited awareness we live life sequentially; we are born, we live and we die. Cosmically time is much broader. What we live in a lifetime is but a moment on the cosmic clock.
