






Figure 10.2. Hispanic Population, 2000




Figure 10.3. Asian Population, 2000


ATLANTA METROPOLITAN ATLANTA OFFICE PARKS ATLANTA CITY LIMITS

SCENARIOS

GENTRIFICATION SCENARIO

In this scenario, caution has been thrown to the wind. As the intown area becomes more desirable, developers offer larger deals to redevelop Buford Highway.

- PROS
 - Economic prosperity
 - Universal marketability
- CONS
 - Erasure of identity
 - Connection between supply and demand

SUPERFICIALITY SCENARIO

The Halal Guys opened at the start of 2017... People see a restaurant like that and think diversity. They are right in a way but, unlike the case with many Buford Highway businesses, this diversity is superficial.

PROS

- Respects Buford Highway identity
- Allows for growth
- CONS
 - Skin-deep beauty
 - Complacency

ENGAGEMENT SCENARIO

In this situation, communication networks are well-established, government is receptive and reflective of local people and concerns, and development is driven by the best interests of those people.

PROS

- Gives power to residents
- Preserves deeper aspects of identity

CONS

- Economically counterintuitive, short-term
- Far easier said than done
