At the heart of our community since 1985, Collin College is home to award-winning higher education at an affordable cost. The only public college in the county, Collin College offers more than 100 degrees and certificates in a wide range of disciplines. The college is a multi-campus community college district with seven locations.</p>
<p><__s> b-roll of the students walking around SCC (exterior and interior)</p>	<p>The largest campus in the district, Spring Creek Campus, is located in Plano on East Spring Creek Parkway and Jupiter Road. Spring Creek Campus offers a full range of traditional freshman and sophomore level coursework targeted at students bound for university baccalaureate programs.</p>
<p><__s> b-roll of library exterior front with armillary, exterior back with courtyard, reading room showing courtyard, classrooms, study rooms, laptops, PCs Mock Trial courtroom</p>	<p>A recent expansion added a 88,000 square foot library building featuring architecture inspired by Thomas Jefferson's design for the University of Virginia. The library's reading room overlooks a grassy courtyard and fountain area known as "The Commons" where you'll find a peaceful, serene environment ideal for study. The new building also houses classrooms, specialized study rooms, computers and academic centers to aid students. One unique feature is a Mock Trial courtroom where student attorneys can practice pleading cases before the bench and jury box while video and audio systems record presentations for review with professors. Speech and broadcasting classes can also take advantage of the technology in this special classroom.</p>

The building is home to the Honors Institute, the Center for Scholarly and Civic Engagement and the Living Legends Conference Center, which has capacity for _____ people. Spring Creek also features a student development center, veteran services office, café, gymnasium, fitness center, state-of-the-art dance studio, performing art center and art gallery. Just outside is the Brinker Tennis Stadium.</p>

Desk), Heritage Hall, J Building, library, Alumni Hall and Dance Studio) and interiors of classrooms with students in them.</p>	<p>The Preston Ridge Campus is located in Frisco on Wade Boulevard near Preston Road. The campus is set on 100+ acres with 10 buildings surrounding a central quad and anchored by a grand library and light tower. Preston Ridge offers rich and varied coursework for both transfer students and technical programs. All three of the district's large campuses—Spring Creek, Preston Ridge and Central Park Campus in McKinney—have comprehensive course offerings and facilities to accommodate classes in the social sciences, communications and humanities, business and computer science, mathematics and natural sciences, and fine arts.</p>
<p><__s> b-roll of convergence lab, ICHE kitchens and Red Room</p>	<p>The fast-growing Preston Ridge Campus is also home to technology programs like the Convergence Technology Center, which is a National Science Foundation Advanced Technical Education National Center of Excellence, and the National Information, Security and Geospatial Technology Consortium, which is funded by a \$20 million federal grant. Preston Ridge is also home base to the Institute of Hospitality and Culinary Education which houses three commercial teaching kitchens as well as the popular “Red Room” restaurant, which is open to students, employees and the public for special menu presentations.</p>
<p><__s> Library interior, stacks, reading room, PC area, art studio classrooms, big classroom for performance (think it has a piano on a small stage), recording student</p>	<p>The Preston Ridge library building is 103,000 square feet of library resources, computer labs, classrooms and study rooms, along with studios for photography and art as well as music labs. Both Preston Ridge and Spring Creek campuses host commercial music labs, each with a full recording studio featuring high-end equipment, isolation booths, editing resources and recording rooms.</p>
<p><__s> show inside of conference center in a way that makes in seem large, parking garage outside view</p>	<p>The Frisco campus recently added a conference center with capacity for 900 people. Adjacent to the conference center is a multi-level parking garage allows for plenty of student, faculty, staff and visitor parking.</p>
<p><__s> zoom out then into CPC campus library, Central Perks, Student Development area, health science students</p>	<p>Collin College's original campus, the Central Park Campus, been transformed through a major renovation project and now features a Jeffersonian-style library, expanded classroom space, science labs, Central Perks Cafe, and a parking structure as well as an expanded Student Development area. The campus, located in McKinney just west of U.S. Highway 75 on Highway 380, offers a full range of transferable, general education classes as well as allied health programs. On any given day, the hallways at Central Park are buzzing with traditional students along with those in scrubs and uniforms en route to courses in nursing, surgical technology, respiratory therapy, sleep technology, dental hygiene, fire science and law enforcement.</p>

<p><__s> dental lab b-roll</p>	<p>Collin College’s dental hygiene suite consists of a 6,000 square feet including a clinic, radiology laboratory, all purpose science laboratory, dental hygiene classroom and locker room. For hands-on experience, the suite also features eight fully-equipped dental rooms, complete with dental chairs and accessories.</p>
<p><__s> nursing, hospital lab, simulation lab, EMS, fire students (NOT burn tower)</p>	<p>The healthcare facilities include a 4,739 square foot hospital lab with 18 beds and two isolation units as well as a state-of-the-art simulation lab. Please verify} bed, 2,216 square foot simulation lab with “human patient simulators” an intensive care unit, audio-visual systems to allows students to record and review their work. The high-fidelity mannequins in this lab are so lifelike that they can simulate breathing and their eyes even dilate. These facilities are shared by students in nursing, paramedic/EMS and dental hygiene.</p>
<p><__s> surgery lab b-roll</p>	<p>The surgical technology program also has a surgery lab, which features two operating suites.</p>
<p><__s> respiratory lab b-roll</p>	<p>The Collin College Respiratory Care program has a 1,934-square-foot lab at Central Park with 9 beds, ventilators and other resources.</p>
<p><__s> sleep lab broll video or images</p>	<p>Another area of study unique to Collin College is polysomnography, or sleep, technology. Polysomnography students train in Central Park’s two bedrooms fully equipped to monitor sleep.</p>
<p><__s> Pan conference center and Pike Hall</p>	<p>The conference center at Central Park seats up to 350 and overlooks an outdoor patio area. Adjacent to the conference center is Pike Hall, which seats 135.</p>

Libraries throughout the district have abundant study tables and lounge furniture areas as private study rooms for individuals and groups. A full bookstore can be found at each of the three major campuses, and some locations even have vending machines to dispense scantrons, bluebooks, pens, and highlighters for student convenience after hours.</p>
<p><__s> show quick views of each of the four centers..... zoom into Courtyard to transition</p>	<p>In addition to the three large campuses, the college has are four additional locations—the Collin Higher Education Center, the Allen Center, the Rockwall Center and Courtyard Center.</p>
<p><__s> show labs, then solar and/or design equipment briefly</p>	<p>With special focus on continuing education, the Courtyard Center--located near the intersection of Park and Preston in Plano—offers courses for career development and personal enrichment as well as contract and corporate training and small business development. From health careers, to design, real estate and solar power, the Courtyard Center has varied facilities and resources for adults from all walks of life.</p>

<p><__s> hospital lab, student in class (from ACD podcast), sim lab mannequins at CYC,</p>	<p>The recently constructed hospital lab at the Courtyard Center includes a 1,567 square foot simulation hospital and nurses' station with four working hospital beds, six bed-side carts, diagnostic stations, a hospital-grade scale, a wheelchair, two simulation mannequins and adult and infant CPR {missing word?}. Attached to the hospital lab is a scrub room equipped with a two-station sink, pharmacy prep station, autoclave and centrifuge. Some of the classes held in these labs include clinical medical assistant training, electrocardiography, phlebotomy and radiology.</p>
<p><__s> CHEC outside and classroom footage, university offices (and banners or signs showing partners), classrooms, student lounge, lobby and Board room.</p>	<p>In 2010, Collin College opened the Collin Higher Education Center--the county's first university center in McKinney at the intersection of U.S. Highway 75 and the Sam Rayburn Turnpike. Here our university partners offer a junior and senior-level bachelor's degree coursework as well as master's and doctoral degrees. The first two floors of the building house admission representatives and university offices as well as classrooms, study areas and a student lounge. The Collin Higher Education Center also serves as the district headquarters.</p>
