Max Parker lives and works just a few kilometres away from Scientology HQ in West Sussex. The gaming fan is in his late twenties and has an obsession with computers and gadgets. He works as an IT consultant for Reed Business Information, where he's been employed since 2005. Just like Bella, Max leads a very ordinary, private life. In a similar vein to his bride, he also has a quirky side, and is a member of the Facebook group called SAS - the Steak Appreciation Society. His friends are mostly a mix of techie types who live in and around London, and Scientologists who work with him in the IT industry.

The 22-year-old married British IT consultant Max Parker in an intimate, romantic ceremony at

The Dorchester Hotel in Central London last month. Together with a small group of their closest friends, the loved-up couple said "I do" in one of the hotel's smaller function rooms, but spared no expense when it came to hiring out the very best suite, on the ninth floor, for their first night together as husband and wife.

Although there are no photos of Nicole at the wedding, the Aussie actress is staying around the corner from The Dorchester while living in London for her stint in the West End production *Photograph 51*.

The 48-year-old is said to be overjoyed for Bella, the daughter

she and Tom, 53, adopted along with their son Connor. Connor, 20, and Tom were not present at the nuptials, with famously private Bella preferring not to risk her wedding becoming public knowledge before the day.

The details of the special occasion come days after Nicole revealed that she stays in contact with Bella and Connor by text.

"I have four children [she also has Sunday, seven, and Faith, four, with Keith Urban] so to stay in touch... it's very important," Nicole told *DuJour* magazine. A practising Scientologist but by no means as strict as her dad, Bella had a non-denominational ceremony, as Max is not a member

of the controversial church. **The couple have been dating since the beginning of the year, having met through friends.** Max lives and works an hour's drive from London in pretty East Grinstead in West Sussex. Isabella regularly attends the Scientology centre there, and will stay if she's studying courses or visiting Scientology friends.


