WHAT YOUR PATIENT CAN EXPECT

Our specialists will provide a thorough evaluation and develop an individualized treatment plan for patients suffering with new injuries or chronic conditions. During the initial evaluation, our team will review the patient's medical history and perform a physical exam to help identify the specific cause of their pain. Our specialists will then discuss treatment options and describe the frequency and duration of the proposed care plan. We believe it is important to understand and establish expectations. We will talk with your patient about what they hope to achieve and explain what we expect from them in order to achieve that goal.

OUR MEDICATION PHILOSOPHY

We advocate for comprehensive treatment plans that combine lifestyle coaching, alternative therapies, pain psychology, interventional options, physical therapy, medication management, and more. During the initial visit, we will evaluate the patient's list of medications and provide recommendations. At CHPG Dimensions Pain Management our chief goal is to partner with your patient to find a plan that allows their function to be maximized and medication minimized. We do manage medications long term if this is deemed appropriate after evaluation of history, appropriate screening, and in-person consultation with your patient. Please note, we do not write prescriptions for opioids during the first appointment.
