

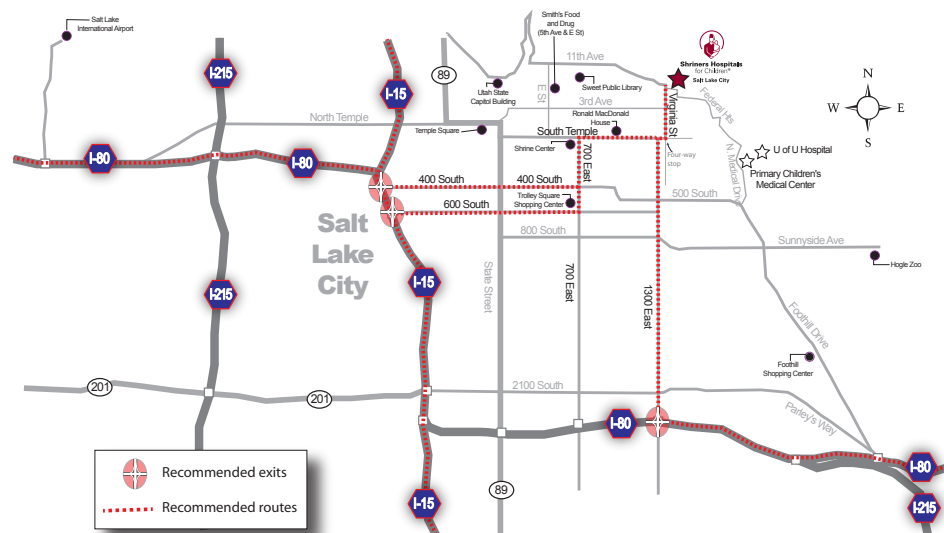
How to Get to Shriners Hospitals for Children® – Salt Lake City

FROM POINTS NORTH: Take I-15 South toward Salt Lake City. Take the 400 South exit. You will then drive east on 400 South until you reach 700 East at Trolley Square. Turn left on 700 East and drive northbound until South Temple Street, turn right. Continue on South Temple Street to Virginia Street (1350 East) and turn left. Proceed up the hill approximately one half mile. Shriners Hospitals for Children® is on your right.

FROM POINTS SOUTH: Take I-15 North toward Salt Lake City. Take the 600 South exit. You will then drive east on 600 South until you reach 700 East at Trolley Square. Turn left on 700 East and drive northbound until South Temple Street, turn right. Continue on South Temple Street to Virginia Street (1350 East) and turn left. Proceed up the hill approximately one half mile. Shriners Hospitals for Children® is on your right.

FROM POINTS EAST: Take I-80 West toward Salt Lake City. Take the 1300 East exit toward Sugar House and turn right onto 1300 East. You will then drive north on 1300 East for about 3.5 miles. Turn right on South Temple Street. You will drive one block and reach a four way stop. Turn left onto Virginia Street (1350 East) and proceed up the hill approximately one half mile. Shriners Hospitals for Children® is on your right.

FROM POINTS WEST AND THE AIRPORT: Take I-80 East toward City Center. Keep right at the fork in the ramp and then drive straight to access the 600 South exit. You will then drive east on 600 South until you reach 700 East at Trolley Square. Turn left on 700 East and drive northbound until South Temple Street, turn right. Continue on South Temple Street to Virginia Street (1350 East) and turn left. Proceed up the hill approximately one half mile. Shriners Hospitals for Children® is on your right.

Completing the Application for Treatment

After receiving the physician referral, an applications coordinator will contact you to complete the Application for Treatment. You may call our patient applications desk at 801.536.3643 if you have not received a phone call within two business days.

Scheduling your first appointment

After the application has been submitted, you can expect to receive another phone call within two business days to schedule your child's appointment.

Insurance and Shriners Hospitals for Children® – Salt Lake City

Shriners Hospitals for Children® provides medical care to its patients at no cost to the patient or the patient's family. Services are always provided regardless of insurance coverage or the patients' ability to pay. If you have insurance, we will bill that insurance company or other third-party payers for medical services provided by the hospital. You are required to help Shriners Hospitals for Children® comply with the insurance company's needs.

Preparing for your appointment

After your appointment is scheduled, we will mail you more detailed information regarding your clinic visit. Here are a few basics to help you prepare:

- Ask your primary care provider for x-rays and medical records.
- Please also bring medications your child takes, insurance cards and your child's most recent wheelchair, braces, splints, prosthetics or other orthopaedic items.
- Dress your child in loose fitting clothes. Please bring a pair of shorts.

- Request an interpreter or other assistive communication services if needed.

Resources to help with your visit

- Transportation: If you are coming by air or on a bus, please call our main desk in advance for our free shuttle to pick you up.
- Housing: Patients coming from out of state may need lodging while in Salt Lake City. Many families qualify for financial assistance for hotel costs. Please call our housing coordinator for assistance.
