

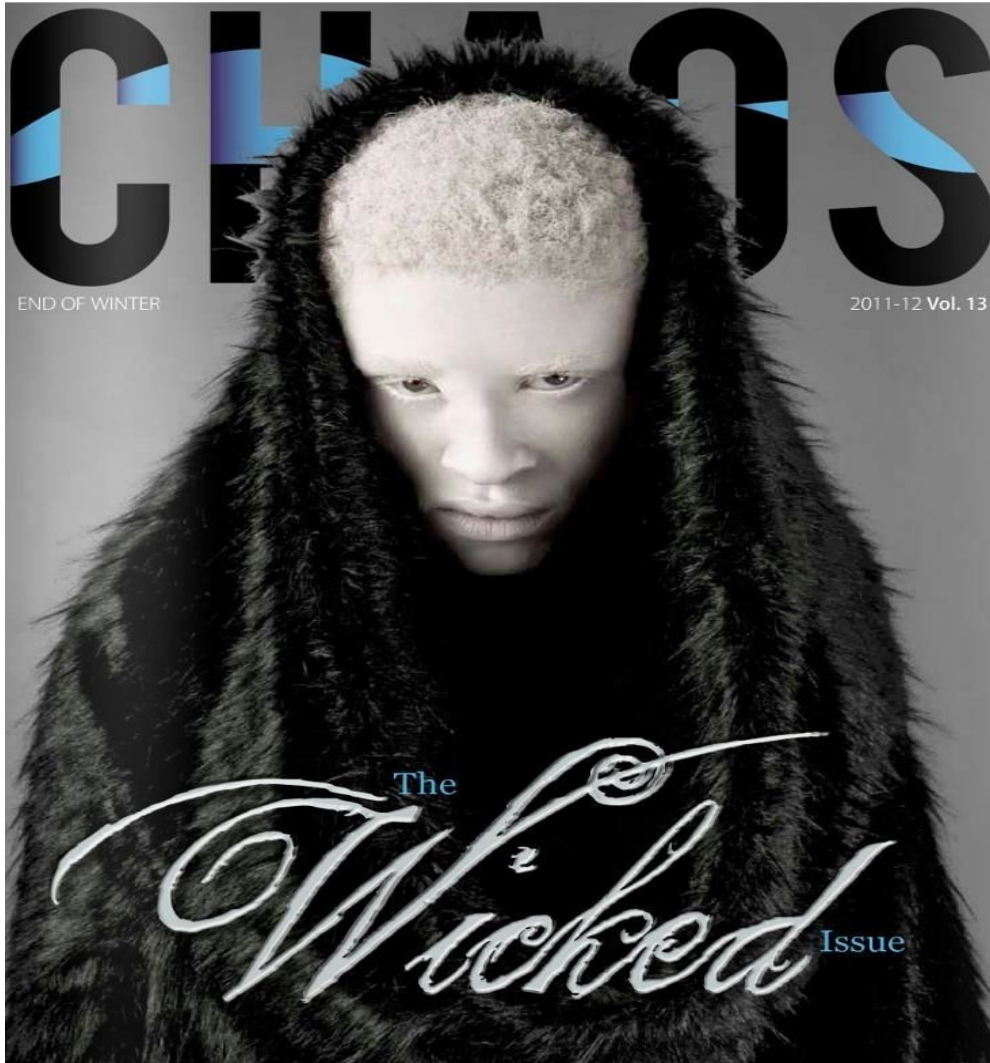
Five Diverse Fashion Models That You Should Know
