acquitted, figures show. In 2013-14, 161 people were prosecuted under the Offensive Behaviour at Football and Threatening Communications

(Scotland) Act 2012.
The majority (154) were for offensive behaviour at matches, with a not guilty outcome in 74

cases (48%).

The previous year 91 were prosecuted under the same law, with 25 people acquitted (27%).
