THE HISTORY OF DUBAI

From a Small Fishing Settlement to a Global Phenomenon

After the founding of the Al Maktoum Dynasty in a small fishing settlement of 19th century Dubai, foreign traders were drawn to the city due to the declaration that they will be exempt from tax. The population gradually doubled, and Dubai's famous pearl industry began to boom, followed by fishing and, most notably, sea trade in the 1950s.

But it wasn't until the 1960s economic boom when the traders started to settle in, and the legendary rise of Dubai began. Dubai's population grew exponentially, and the city slowly reinvented itself as a leading business and tourist destination, home to astounding islands, the Emirates Airline, the Dubai World Cup, Burj Al Arab, the Dubai Shopping Festival and, most famously, Burj Khalifa and The Dubai Mall.

THE HISTORY OF DUBAI CREEK

The Dubai Creek is where the story of Dubai’s bold evolution began. In 1833, the Bani Yas tribe settled on the banks of the Creek and established the Al Maktoum dynasty. By the turn of the century, the Creek was serving as a port for dhows coming from as far as India and East Africa. By the 1950s, it had become the regional headquarters of trade. The Royals further expanded the Creek throughout the 1960s by dredging shallow areas, building breakwaters and converting the beach to a quay, transforming Dubai Creek into the harbour it is today.



DUBAI RESIDENTS

The Rise of a Diverse, Thriving Population

As one of the key players in the global economy, Dubai welcomes expatriates with open arms. Due to its policies of openness and inclusivity, the emirate's population is consistently on the rise - from 183,187 residents in 1975 to over 3 million today. Famously, the population of Dubai comprises more than 200 nationalities, which further cements its stature as a global model for tolerance and diversity.

DUBAI TOURISTS

One of the Most Visited Cities in the World

Due to its hassle-free visa system, including free visas on arrival for European, Chinese, Indian and Saudi Arabian nationals, to name but a few, Dubai is the fourth most visited city in the world. According to the 2017 Global Destination Cities Index by Mastercard, the emirate welcomed a staggering 15.79 million international tourists, surpassing the likes of Kuala Lumpur, Hong Kong and Barcelona. Dubai International Airport welcomed 904,940 passengers in the same year, which made it one of the world's busiest airports for international travel.

In 2016, Mastercard ranked Dubai as the city with the highest international overnight visitor spend - a whopping USD 28.50 billion, more than New York, London and Singapore. According to analysis from the Dubai Chamber of Commerce, spending within Dubai's tourism and travel sector is expected to reach more than \$56 billion in 2022.





An Ideally Positioned Haven



The six-square-kilometre Dubai Creek Harbour occupies the ideal Dubai location. Only 10 minutes' drive from Downtown Dubai and 10 minutes away from Dubai International Airport, residents and visitors alike will have easy access to two major Dubai roads, Al Khail Road and Ras Al Khor Road.



RAS AL KHOR

Bursting With Beautiful Wildlife

At the shore of Dubai Creek is the Ras Al Khor Wildlife Sanctuary, one of the few protected urban areas in the world renowned for attracting migratory birds. The sanctuary is also home to flocks of pink flamingos and 450 other animal species. Residents and visitors will be able to enjoy life in an ideal location close to water and nature in remarkable surroundings.



DUBAI CREEK TOWER

A New Global Icon for the 21st Century

The design of the Dubai Creek Tower was inspired by the minaret, the tower-like structure that is traditionally used for the Muslim call to prayer. Part of the inspiration was also drawn from the lily flower, as evident by the elongated oval-shaped bud at the top and steel cables evoking the delicate ribbing of the flower's leaves at the bottom.

The genius behind the future global icon is the renowned neo-futuristic Spanish architect, Santiago Calatrava.







DUBAI CREEK TOWER

Eclipsing even Burj Khalifa, the world's tallest structure since 2010, the Dubai Creek Tower represents the quintessence of a 21st-century tourist attraction. In addition to revolutionary design and record-breaking attributes, it will feature multiple cutting-edge observation decks with 360° views of Dubai Creek Harbour and the metropolis beyond. Millions of tourists will have easy access from Dubai Square to Dubai Creek Tower, and vice-versa.





DUBAI CREEK PLAZA

A Plaza Like No Other

At the foot of Dubai Creek Tower, an exciting experiential destination awaits. Dubai Creek Plaza is a clock-shaped haven of landscaping, palm trees and water features stretching across 0.5 kilometre of land – the length of ten Olympic-sized swimming pools. Visitors to Dubai Creek Tower will be able to wander from the Tower to the Plaza to the innovative retail destination through a cutting-edge underground extension. What's more, they can enjoy various events at the spectacular Dubai Creek Plaza amphitheatre.







DUBAI CREEK TOWER

An Icon Rises

In May 2018, Emaar completed the concrete placement for Dubai Creek's Tower pile cap two months ahead of schedule. The pile cap is an approximately 20-metre thick multi-layered, tiered reinforced concrete top that covers and transfers the load to the foundation barrettes. To reach this milestone, more than 450 skilled professionals from across the world had to pour 50,000 cubic meters of concrete weighing about 120,000 tonnes or the weight of the CN Tower in Canada. Additionally, 16,000 tonnes of steel reinforcement was placed – just over twice the weight of the Eiffel Tower.



CREEK MARINA

A Rapidly Growing Metropolis

The first heartbeats of Dubai Creek Harbour are anticipated before the end of 2018 with the scheduled launch of Creek Marina in the Creek Island Dubai district. This flourishing waterfront destination will introduce residents and tourists to the glamorous world of yachting only moments away from Dubai Creek Tower. Over a dozen projects have already launched on the island with hundreds of apartments sold out to discerning buyers. A premier six-tower residential project, Dubai Creek Residences, is scheduled for handover in early 2019. Infrastructure, including bridges and access roads, is fast taking shape.





An Authentic City Experience






SECOND FLOOR
