

Get your nails done

GLOSSARY OF ENGAGEMENT RING CUTS

Find your angle

Straight on or from the side? Experiment with different angles to make sure you display your stones and your setting.

Too much of a good thing

Believe it or not, some people might not want to see a whole collage of ring photos on their Facebook feed. Experiment with a few different shots, but only share one.

Keep it quality

Your phone will never match up to a DSLR camera, but that doesn't mean you should settle for poor quality photos. Make sure your engagement ring is in focus and avoid the zoom as this creates a more pixelated image.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU HATE YOUR ENGAGEMENT RING

Background is key

You want something pretty but not too distracting so a nice landscape shot is great. If this is proving tricky, lay your hand on top of some plain furniture and always keep your background uncluttered.

High handed

If your hands are looking a little more veiny than you'd like - hold them above your head for 30 seconds so that they lose some of their swelling and look a little more youthful.




