


THE ROYAL CRESCENT **HOTEL & SPA BATH**

THE TOP 10 THINGS TO LOOK OUT FOR WHEN BOOKING YOUR VENUE

1. MUSIC

Venues have to have a licence to play live music, but this means they will usually have a set time at which the tunes have to be turned off. Check the timings they have fit with the celebrations you had in mind, but don't fret too much if they seem really early. Remember your guests will have been celebrating since the afternoon so will be ready for bed at midnight.



It's not uncommon for venues to have preferred caterers for you to use, and the same may go for other suppliers, such as florists and cake makers. If you had your own suppliers in mind ask how flexible these rules are before booking.

3. CEREMONY ROOM CAPACITY

Check how many guests can be seated in the ceremony room at your venue. These numbers will be based on health and safety regulations, so don't be tempted to invite a couple more people on the basis that you'll be able to squash them in, as they won't be allowed.

4. CORKAGE

Not all venues will let you supply your own alcohol, and some will have a prohibitive corkage fee, which will make it cheaper to buy your wine through them. Bear in mind that a corkage fee usually applies to any alcoholic mini favours too.



5. SET UP

Ask your venue when you'll be able to come in and start decorating your venue. Some offer a few hours before the ceremony start whereas others allow you to come in the day before. It usually depends on whether there are any other weddings booked.

6. CONFETTI

Some places aren't keen on having to clear up the aftermath of your confetti moment, and others will ask that you only use biodegradable versions. Thankfully, natural petals not only look beautiful, but they smell incredible too – bonus.

7. USE OF OUTDOOR SPACE

If your venue has beautiful grounds, check you're allowed access to it all, both for photographs and for guests to mingle with drinks. It's also worth finding out if there's a time at which all guests have to move inside.

8. MINIMUM SPEND

Regardless of how many guests you're

having, some venues will ask that you spend over a certain amount of money in order to secure your day there. This usually isn't a problem if you're inviting lots of guests, but can be an issue for smaller weddings.

9. OVERNIGHT ACCOMMODATION

If your venue has guest accommodation, they might specify that you have to book out a certain number of rooms as part of your package. If this is the case, double-check that you have enough friends and family members who'll want to stay in them, and that they aren't priced out of their budget too.

10. WEDDING COORDINATOR?

Find out if your venue has a dedicated wedding coordinator to help you through the planning. If not, make sure you have a contact at the venue who can help you with any questions.
