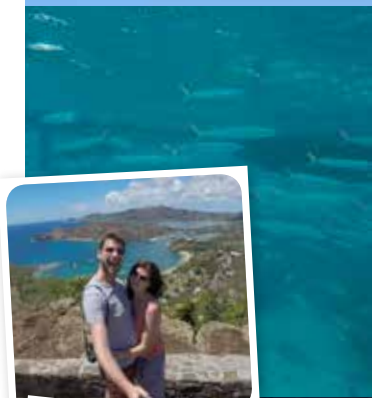
BREAKFAST SPOTS DON'T GET MUCH PRETTIER THAN THIS!

A 40-minute drive through the lush landscape dotted with colourful houses and we arrived at the delightfully laid back Keyonna Beach Hotel. As soon as we stepped into the open-air beachfront lounge we were greeted with a smile, a cocktail and a quick walk around the incredible bijou beauty.

The boutique hotel features four beachfront plunge pool cottages, 12 beach-view cottages, eight beach house rooms plus a fab swimming pool all topped off with elegant colonial furnishings. We stayed in a beautiful beach-view cottage with seriously romantic outdoor his 'n' hers showers, a king-sized four poster bed, veranda and air-conditioning. The absence of television and radio made us sink into island life almost instantly.



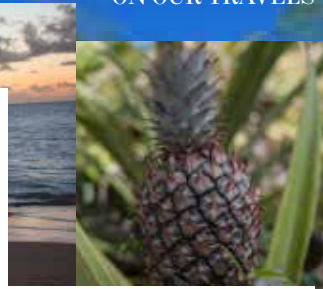


The resort is all-inclusive and offers breakfast, lunch, afternoon tea and dinner as well as a fully-stocked in-room minibar. We couldn't get enough of the authentic Caribbean flavours – highlights included the coconut bread for breakfast, the jerk chicken for lunch and sensational king fish for dinner.

However, the icing on the (already incredible tasty cake) has to be the beachside setting.

All the rooms are positioned with a view of the sea – and what a view it is! Our cottage was situated right by Turner's Beach, a secluded long, white bay with gorgeous views of the calm Caribbean waters, and the softest white sand in the world (fact). To top it off the hotel is equipped with private Carib beach beds (yes that's right – a bed on the beach!) where you can relax with your new husband and listen to nothing but the gentle ebb and flow of the sea. We didn't even need to move to get drinks – as soon as our throats got a teensy bit dry a rum cart trundled along to serve us a potent Piña Colada!


Not sounding relaxing enough? There are also fantastic beachside bi-weekly yoga classes and amazing massages on offer
