CHENGDU

This Sichuan restaurant on Amoy Street serves favourites like hot pot and kungpow chicken alongside lesser-known gems like sour soup, where sole fish fillet is cooked in a broth with Sichuan peppercorns, ginger and preserved pickled vegetables. 
THE BLACK SWAN

DREAM OF KAHYANGAN ART RESTO

Merging the best of Chinese and Javanese gastronomic heritage, this restaurant is known for its *tumpang* (a cone of rice with vegetables and meat) and *es teler* (fruit cocktail in coconut milk).
