Global Upstream Spending Report released



The IHS Global Upstream Spend Report is out for August 2016. Figures indicate that overall spending and activity will start to strengthen during the second half of 2016 and into 2017.

• Upstream E&P spending in 2017 is expected to recover to USD \$403 billion, up 7% from 2016, but

it will remain 43% below 2014 levels.

- North America will be leading gains in 2017, but spending will remain under half of what it was prior to the collapse in 2015–16.
- Offshore spending will decline in 2017 owing to longer lead times between project sanction and project activity/spending.
- Operating expenditure (OPEX) for 2016 is expected to be USD \$446 billion, climbing steadily to surpass 2014 spending levels by 2019 as prices start recovering and new fields come online.
