## Luke 18:17-Truly I tell you, anyone who will not receive the kingdom of God like a little child will never enter it". NIV

Every time we tried it I took a small step back so she could be further away from me. Her hesitation has gone from 100 to 0. Now Im amazed at how easily she will jump on me because I have gained her trust and now she knows I will never let her fall.

If I being a sinner can love my child so much that I will never let her fall, how much more will God being a good God, will care for me! I pray that I can trust in Him the same way my little girl trusts in me. That I will jump into His will knowing that He is faithful and that He will never let me fall. Knowing that He will catch me even if Im 2 inches away from hitting the floor. And even if I do fall, and break into tiny little pieces, from every corner He will gather me and put me back together again.
