Travel is very much on the to-do list of most women and this is why Sumitra Senapaty founded the all women's travel club called Women on Wanderlust — WOW. Rhea Dhanbhoora finds out more from this globetrotter...

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Tell us a little bit about what Women on Wanderlust is all about...

WOW is a travel club of women, for women and by women. It's a social platform for women to travel around the globe. It is a single window contact and service point, free of the worries of safety, and single occupancy supplement, well researched itineraries, with elements that are attractive to a well informed and evolved woman. Besides travel, there are several WOW occasions to renew friendships with your travel companions over movies, lunches, wine evenings and weekend outings.

Why did you decide it had to be a woman oriented club?

As a travel writer, I travelled across the world. Women would often say how lucky I was, and how they wished they could travel. I saw genuine passion for travel in them. Men did not seem to need any platform; families were being served by innumerable travel agents, with whom women were not comfortable, especially if they were travelling on their own. And so, I decided to use my knowledge of travel destinations, and decided to share some of my luck with the women by providing a platform like this for them and the rest is history.

Was it difficult starting out?

The only difficulty was spreading the word around. But, I am very thankful to the press, who saw something special in WOW, and decided to spread the word. And then there was word of mouth. As women went on their perfect holidays at down to earth prices, with personalised service, they spread the word in the right circles. However it did take a while for it to catch on.

How do you'll decide where to go and what place to visit next?
