UCF student accused of filming female student in campus restroom

UCF student Shaun Anthony Ragasa, 19, was arrested by the UCF Police Department Sunday and is being charged with video voyeurism, a third degree felony.

Ragasa is being accused of secretly recording a fellow female student inside a campus restroom.

According to arrest documents, the nursing student was allegedly filming the student in January at the Student Union.

Ragasa denied the accusations in his report to the police, but videos of other students using the restroom were later found on his phone by authorities, according to the police report.

Ragasa, a first time offender, was held without bond according to Orange County Jail records.

UPDATE (2-14-17): The UCF Police
Department announced in a press release
this afternoon that Ragasa has received an
additional charge after a second victim
elected to press charges.

Ragasa, who is accused of secretly recording a fellow female student inside a campus restroom, has now been additionally charged with video voyeurism

after detectives discovered additional footage that appeared to be taken inside an off-campus private residence without the knowledge or consent of the person being recorded, according to UCF Police Department press release.

Police believe Regasa, a pending nursing major, tampered with air conditioning to gain access to the bathroom stall, the release states.

"In today's world, you have to pay attention to your surroundings all the time," said UCFPD Chief Richard Beary in a press conference this morning, "[These cases] are invasive, they're illegal, and I think what this case shows is that if it's brought to our attention—even if we have sketchy details—we're going to follow up until we find who's responsible and hold that person accountable for their actions."

UCF Victim Services, who gave support to the victims, is offering to assist any additional victims or those who are concerned.
