
THE ULTIMATE PROM GUIDE 9 SECRETS OF HOW TO HAVE **A PERFECT PROM!**

5 Make-up

So, use purple tones for brown eyes, grey shadows for blue eyes and brown and golden colours for green eyes.







Another important thing to remember is DO NOT match your eye shadow to your dress; instead use colours that will complement what you're wearing. For instance, if you're wearing a metallic or red dress, keep your make-up more simple and let your frock do the talking! If you're wearing a blue dress, a silver eye-shadow will make your eyes pop. If you're wearing a pink dress, what about a sparkly gold eyeshadow?

Another great product to use is a long-lasting lipstick so that even after sipping your drinks and eating all the buffet food...you'll still have the perfect pout! Remember: if you're going for statement eyes, choose a more subtle lip colour and don't forget to bring your lippie with you in your bag so you can touch it up during the night!

6 Shoes

Step 3: Remember your occasion
