Walls are in place and finishes such as doors, hardware and signage are almost entirely in place, too. The floors in classrooms are installed. We have even added fixtures, sound proofing materials on the walls, and the new theater seats. Many of the lighting fixtures inside, and lamp posts outside, are wired and already illuminating the space. The theater's acoustical ceiling clouds are hung, and wood paneling surrounding the theater and the control room is installed. Remaining tasks include painting and audio/visual work, obtaining permits for occupancy, moving equipment and furniture into the classrooms, and of course, cleaning.
