Each video will be shot reportage-style in a location that suits the interviewee – for example, we could interview Lisa Pagotto in her favorite hotel, Nathan McLay in his office or a recording studio or bar, Stanislava Pinchuk in her home or studio, and Josh Niland in his restaurant.

Our talent will enjoy a glass of Johnnie Walker as they chat and each interview will end with a question about the next step. For example, questions for Nathan McLay could include:

- -You've gone from working out of your home to running one of the most successful independent labels in Australia what was one of the biggest challenges you faced along the way and how did you overcome it?
  - What was the biggest mistake you've made and what did you learn from it?
  - Was there a time you felt like giving up and, if so, what kept you going?
    - What career achievements or moments are you most proud of?
      - Do you have any as-yet unrealised career goals you're working towards?
         -What will your next step be?

Using still imagery and quotes captured during the video interviews, we will create a series of meme-style posts for social media. To extend this, we will also create four illustrations (one each to represent the style, food, arts and business pillars) that can be teamed with inspirational (but non-cheesy) quotes, such as "Follow your blisters" and "You can make an omelette without breaking any eggs, it's just a really bad omelette".
