

# EVIT Cosmetology

## Admission Requirements:

- Must have at least a 2.0 GPA.
- Have to have 2 passing English credits and 10 passing credits overall. As well as two copies of the current high school transcript.
- If a student falls under a 2.0 GPA they have to submit the standardized test scores which are AIMS, Stanford, etc.. The student needs to print out their discipline record from their home high school along with their attendance.
- EVIT won't accept students with terrible attendance. The student needs to fill out an immunization record, which tells the school if that student has any medical issues or personal beliefs.
- Then print a copy of their social security # and lastly the signed understanding of the packet

## Tuition and Fees:

- EVIT is tuition free if you are in high school or have a scholarship.
- There are fees for supplies which is about ranges from \$300 to \$900.
- If you are not a high school student then you have to pay the adult fees. Which includes tuition and supplies fee.

## Campus Housing:

- EVIT is not a campus for students to live at because it is not a university.
- Some of the students might roommate in apartments or condos nearby since it is usually cheaper to do so.

## Numbers of Students that attend:

- At the East Campus in Gilbert, there are about 240 cosmo students.
- Th the Main in downtown Mesa there is about 360 cosmo students.

## Student Demographics:

- The range for cosmo students is 15 to 22.
- The male to female ratio is 1:6.
- The majority race at EVIT is white 70%, while African Americans are 20%, Hispanic 5% and American Indian 5%.
