BOWIE: BY THE PAL WHO PLAYED MATCHMAKER AND CHANGED THE ICONIC STAR'S LIFE FOREVER

THE man who introduced David Bowie to his future wife Iman has told how the pop icon was racked with loneliness before falling in love at first sight.

Bowie was at the height of worldwide fame but trapped in a desperately solitary life at the end of the 1980s. according to his close friend and personal hairdresser Teddy Antolin.

Too famous to lead an ordinary life. the megastar from a London suburb struggled with the adulation of millions

But that changed when Teddy arranged for the troubled star to meet supermodel Iman at his birthday party in Los Angeles in 1990.

The pair immediately hit it off and Bowie – who died last week aged 69 from liver cancer - dedicated his time away from music to being the perfect partner for Iman, now 60.

Speaking exclusively to the Sunday People, Teddy, 68, said: "David was very lonely. It was so sad – all this hard work David did each day and then he was



DAVID Bowie has left behind enough new and unreleased material to produce chart success for at least the next five years. He had bravely refused to look on his impending death as the end but merely the beginning of a new phase of his career, a source has revealed.

The 69-year-old star left detailed instructions on what music should be released and when. A pal revealed that Bowie had always been amused by Elvis Presley manager Col Tom Parker's adage that "death was a good career move"

Among the first planned release this year will be some unreleased material and some othe tracks from earlier in Bowie's career.

Sales booming

singles have been bought since his death. Blackstar, released on his 69th birthday, is at No1 with 18 more in the top 100 albums. Thirteen singles, including Heroes, Changes and Starman, charted.
His tracks have been streamed over

19 million times on services such as Spotify, Apple Music and Google Play.
