Anticipating the price you will get to sell your junk car is based on a huge number of factors. From the supply and demand of the scrap metal market to the salvageable parts of the vehicle, knowing how to scrap a car is an art in itself.

Often, scrap car buyers will take at least a few basic criteria into consideration before deciding how much a scrap car is worth.

For example, there's the value of the scrap metal on the vehicle; smaller cars such as the Ford KA are relatively light and therefore have less useable scrap metal, while larger vehicles such as Vans or Land Rover are considerably heavier and ultimately more valuable.

Also, there's the location of the buyer; the further the distance a buyer needs to transport scrap cars to a car recycling company; the more they will deduct from the prices they give to cover their costs.

Selling your car for scrap to us is easy, but to ensure you're able to sell the car on the same day without any complications, be sure to bring the following documents to your appointment:

- V5 Logbook/registration certificate
- Service history and MOT certificate
- Finance settlement letter – if applicable

Unfortunately, you cannot sell your junk car for cash without a logbook as the V5 is an official document of ownership. This ensures that all cars sold for scrap to car recycling companies are certified to be sold and prevent unauthorized sales (such as stolen cars) taking place.

While some car removal companies do turn a blind eye to instances in which a car is sold without official documentation, as an established car buying company, we do not put unauthorized sales through our car disposal process.

Scrapping a car without a title is not possible with Rhino Car Scrap, while we do strive to offer the most convenient, hassle-free scrap car recycling service in the country, we cannot purchase a car without official documentation of ownership (the logbook/V5).

After we scrap your car, we will issue you with an official DVLA Certificate of Destruction. This proves that we have removed your scrap car's details from the DVLA's database and reassures your peace of mind.

Without a DVLA Certificate of Destruction, as the owner of the car, you would still be liable to pay road tax and could receive a fine from the DVLA.

It's a legal requirement for all scrap cars to be issued with a certificate of destruction – but don't worry about contacting the DVLA as we will send your DVLA Certificate of Destruction to you after your vehicle has been scrapped.
