Chairman and CEO of TCL Corporation Li Dongsheng also offered comments at the unveiling. "Today TCL enters a partnership with the Chinese Theatre of Hollywood, which features a long history and extensive cultural achievement," he said. "I believe we will take advantage of this chance and make sure this will be a place that brings movie fans and visitors the beauty from the perfect integration of art, technology and innovation. Thank you, Hollywood."

The partnership was marked with handshakes all around, a champagne toast, and a rain of confetti as the curtain dropped to reveal the new Chinese Theatre logo.
