LOYOLA STUNS MIAMI IN THE UPSET EVERYONE EXPECTED

DALLAS, Texas- To continue the NCAA March Madness Basketball Tournament action, The University of Miami faced off against Loyola University of Chicago on Thursday March 15, 2018.

In an upset victory, Loyola Chicago claimed the victory over Miami, 64-62, sealed by a late game drive with 20 seconds left, after Miami missed free throw shots. The ball was sent to Donte Ingram, who scored the final points of the game with 0.3 seconds left in the game, and sealing the victory for Loyola Chicago.
