City of Upland: Alleged Hit-and-Run 3-21

A 59 year-old-man was found in critical conditions after an alleged hit-and-run early Wednesday morning, according to Upland Police.

“We are investigating this incident vigorously, Officer Milkovich said. “The severity and nature of his injuries, plus the debris we found, leads us to believe this was a hit- and-run incident.”

Michael Greer was transported to San Antonio Regional Hospital, where he was treated for three broken ribs, a collapsed lung, abrasions to his chest and back and a dislocated hip, spokesperson at the hospital, Seligman said.

“He appears to have been hit on his right side. His broken ribs, his collapsed lung and his dislocated hip are all on the right side,” Milkovich said. “We are doing everything we can to give him the best care possible.”

Police deduced that the man was injured at about 2:15 a.m.

A call was received at 2:45 a.m. and the police arrived at the scene on Euclid Avenue at 2:52 a.m. where Greer was found unconscious, Milkovich said.

“We hate to think that someone would have hit this man and just left him on the street, but that appears to be the situation we are dealing with,” Milkovich said.
