More recently, in the 70s, constraints on marijuana tightened even more when President Richard Nixon signed an act to establish a categorical rating system for substance use. California led the way with the Compassionate Use Act of 1996 which permitted select patients to use medical marijuana.

In the same year, Arizona followed suit and approved Proposition 200 to allow physicians to prescribe Cannabis.

In subsequent years, 33 states would come to legalize the medical use of Cannabis. 2012 became the most significant year in Cannabis history when Colorado and Washington voters passed referendums legalizing marijuana for recreational use. An industry once controlled by the black market became legitimized and regulated.
