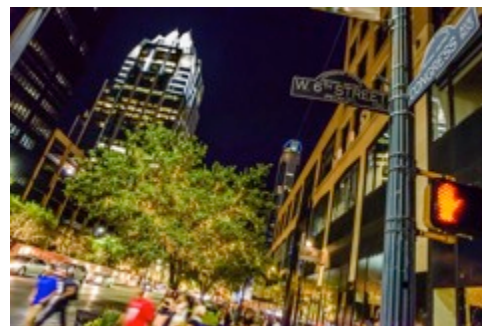
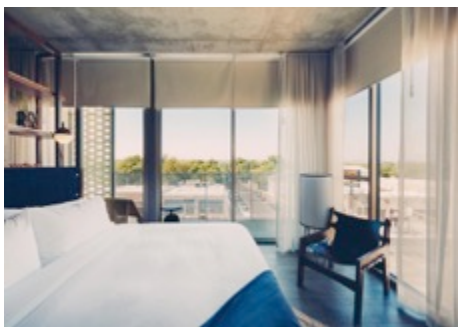
1. Vegas Baby!

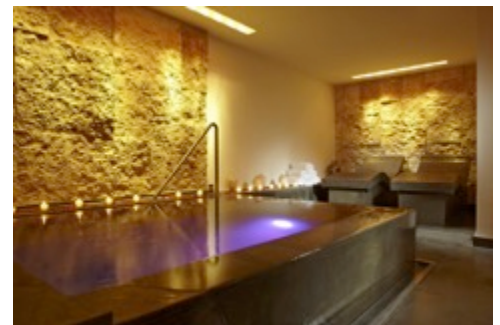
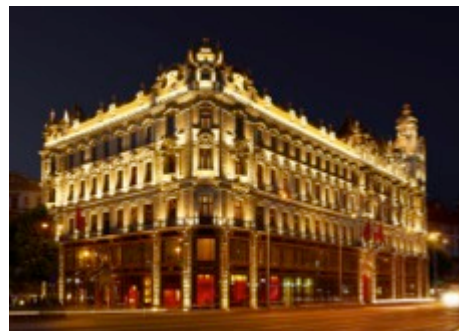
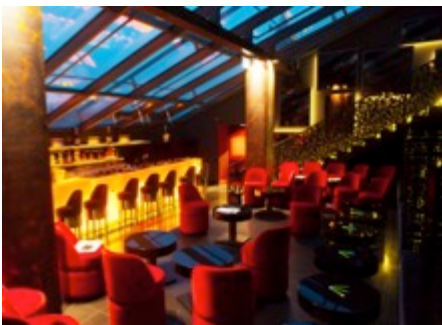

common rooms. Its inclusive set-up is the perfect spot to expand your clubbing group and meet new..."friends".

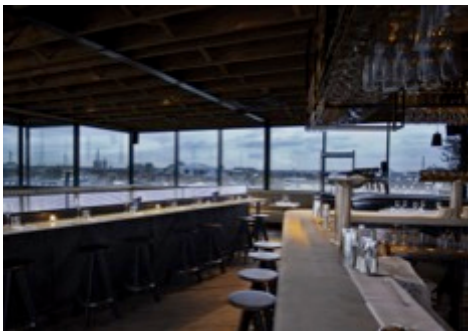
