In a world where technology is constantly advancing, you never know what's around the corner...unless you're clairvoyant, a time traveller, or a high-tech hotel.

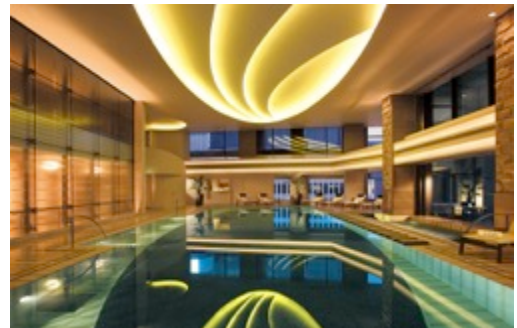

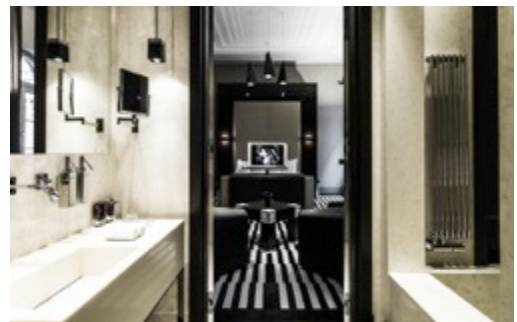

The suave and sophisticated architecture alone could have come straight out of a bond movie, but what really makes this hotel high-tech are the finger scanners instead of room keys!

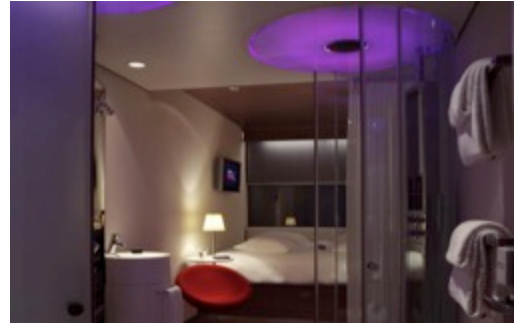

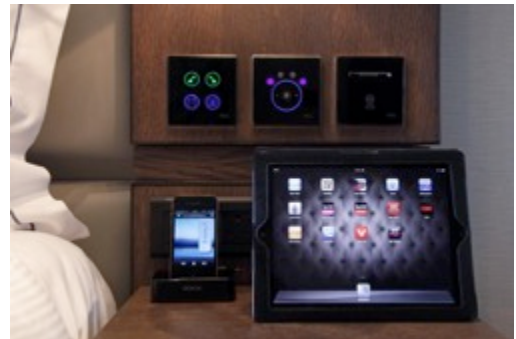

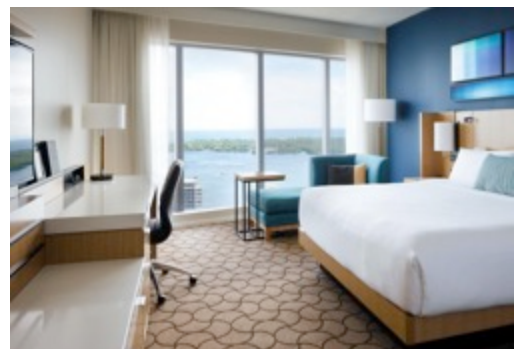
