Purpose:

This work instruction explains how to continuously cycle through the screens of all the active applications running on a PC or laptop.

System Requirements:

- AnalogX Auto Tab software
- PC or laptop

Optional:

- Television monitor
- HDMI cable or DVI/VGA cable



1 To download the AnalogX Auto Tab software:

- Click **DOWNLOAD NOW**.
- Click **Run**.


- On the **AnalogX End User Agreement** window, click **Accept**.

- On the **Installation Directory** window, click **Continue**.

- On the **Installation Directory** pop-up, click **Yes**.

<p>2 To run the Auto Tab program in the left-hand taskbar:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">Click the Start menu.Select Auto Tab.	
<p>3 To start using the Auto Tab program:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">In the taskbar, right click the Auto Tab icon.Click Config.	
<p>4 To set the amount of time each application needs to remain on the screen:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">In the Cycle Time (secs) text field, type the required time (in seconds). Note: The default cycle time is 10 seconds.Click OK. <p>Note: To display the screens on a television monitor, connect the PC or laptop to the monitor with a HDMI cable or DVI/VGA cable.</p>
